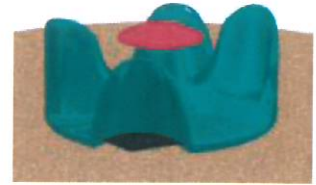

ZOOM with the St. Louis Branch Library Book Club

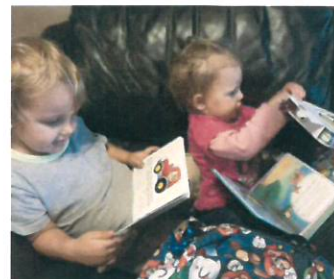
