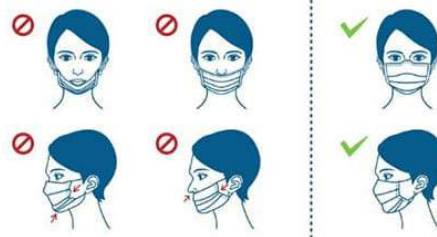

Graduation Fees: Gr. 12 \$50.00

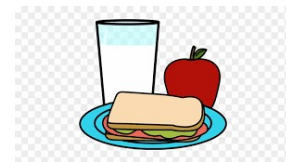

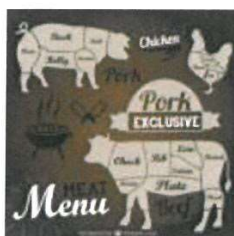

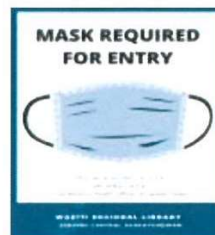
ZOOM with the St. Louis Branch Library Book Club
